

1. STUMBLE (verb): ठोकर खाना

Pronunciation: stuhm.bl

Meaning: to trip or momentarily lose one's balance; almost fall

Synonym: Trip, falter, slip

Antonym: Glide, stride , rise

Sentence: He stumbled over the uneven pavement but quickly regained his balance.

2. TUMULTUOUS (adj) : हंगामेदार

Pronunciation: tyoo.muhl.tyoo.uhs

Meaning: making a loud, confused noise; uproarious

Synonym: Turbulent, chaotic ,loud

Antonym: Calm, peaceful, soft

Sentence: The tumultuous applause at the end of her speech was overwhelming.

3. PRECARIOUSLY (adv): अनिश्चितता

Pronunciation: pruh.keuh.ree.uhs.lee

Meaning: in a way that is not securely in position and is likely to fall or collapse

Synonym: Dangerously, unsafely ,risky

Antonym: Securely, safely, harmless

Sentence: The vase was placed precariously on the edge of the shelf.

4. CONFLUENCE (noun): संगम

Pronunciation: kawn.floo.uhns

Meaning: the junction of two rivers, especially rivers of approximately equal width

Synonym: Junction, meeting ,convergence

Antonym: Divergence, separation

Sentence: The town is situated at the confluence of two great rivers.

5. STIMULUS (noun): प्रोत्साहन

Pronunciation: sti.myoo.luhs

Meaning: something that rouses or incites to activity

Synonym: Incentive, spur,impulse

Antonym: Deterrent, disincentive ,counterincentive

Sentence: The lower tax rates served as a stimulus for economic growth.

6.NUDGE (verb) : कुहनी से हलका धक्का

Pronunciation: nuhj

Meaning: to prod someone gently, typically with one's elbow, in order to draw their attention to something

Synonym: Prod, poke, butt

Antonym: Pull, tug, hit

Sentence: She nudged her friend to look at the celebrity walking by.

7.RATTLE (verb): खड़खड़ाना

Pronunciation: ra.tld

Meaning: to make a rapid succession of short, sharp noises

Synonym: Clatter, clank, clunk

Antonym: Soothe, calm, secure

Sentence: The old car rattled down the cobblestone street.

8.SPUTTERING (verb): बुद्बुदाहट

Pronunciation: spuh.tuh.ruhng

Meaning: to make explosive popping or sizzling sounds

Synonym: Splutter, spit, muttering

Antonym: Hum, whisper, vocal

Sentence: The engine was sputtering, indicating it might soon fail.

9.MONITORABLE (adj): निगरानी योग्य

Pronunciation: monitorable

Meaning: capable of being monitored

Synonym: Trackable, observable

Antonym: Untraceable, unobservable

Sentence: The new software made the system more monitorable by the IT department.

10. FORTHRIGHTLY (adv): हर पखवाड़े


Pronunciation: fawth.rite

Meaning: directly and clearly

Synonym: Directly, candidly, frank

Antonym: Evasively, indirectly, quiet

Sentence: She forthrightly stated her opinions during the meeting.



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
