



1.MoYAS Announced to Replace Dhyan Chand Lifetime Award with Arjuna Lifetime

The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MoYAS) in India recently announced a significant change in the recognition of sporting excellence in the country. The Dhyan Chand Lifetime Achievement Award, which was previously the highest honor given to sportspersons for their lifetime contribution to Indian sports, will now be replaced by the **Arjuna Lifetime Achievement Award**.

- The Arjuna Award (Lifetime) will be given for lifetime contribution to sports development.
- Dhyan Chand award is presented to individuals excelling in disciplines that are a part of the Olympic Games, Paralympics Games, Asian Games and Commonwealth Games.
- The award consists of a statue of Dhyanchand, a certificate, a ceremonial dress and a cash prize of 10 lakh rupees.

2. Global Nature Conservation Index 2024

The Global Nature Conservation Index 2024 (GNCI 2024) is a ranking that evaluates and compares countries based on their overall performance in nature conservation efforts. The index considers various indicators related to the preservation and restoration of ecosystems, biodiversity, and natural resources. It aims to provide a





comprehensive picture of how well countries are protecting their natural environments and meeting global conservation targets.

- Luxembourg has topped the index followed by Estonia and Denmark ranked at 2nd and 3rd position.
- The index is developed by Goldman Sonnenfeldt School of Sustainability and Climate Change at Ben-Gurion University of the Negev.
