**Pronunciation:** oh.vuh.velmd

**Meaning:** feeling a strong emotional effect from too many demands or great difficulties

**Synonym:** Overpowered, Swamp,flood

**Antonym:** Unaffected, Calm, bored

**Sentence:** She felt overwhelmed by the amount of work she had to complete before the deadline.

### **2.ACUTE (adjective): तीव्र**

**Pronunciation:** uh.kyoot

**Meaning:** describing something that is severe and sudden in onset

**Synonym:** Severe, Sharp,dire

**Antonym:** Mild, Blunt,bad

**Sentence:** The doctor diagnosed him with acute appendicitis and recommended immediate surgery.

### **3.RESPIRATORY (adjective): श्वसन**

**Pronunciation:** ruh.spi.ray.tree

**Meaning:** relating to the organs involved in breathing, such as the lungs

**Synonym:** Pulmonary, Breathing ,live

**Antonym:**Nonrespiratory, dead, lifeless

**Sentence:** Respiratory diseases can be exacerbated by poor air quality and smoking.

### **4.AWASH (adjective): लहरों से बहाया हुआ**

**Pronunciation:**uh.vawsh

**Meaning:** filled, covered, or completely overrun as if by a flood

**Synonym:** Flooded, Overflowing ,under water

**Antonym:** Dry, Empty,arid

**Sentence:** After the hurricane, the streets were awash with debris.

### **5.OUTBREAK (noun): प्रकोप**

**Pronunciation:** awt.brayk

**Meaning:** a sudden occurrence of something unwelcome,such as war or disease

**Synonym:** Epidemic, Surge, wave

**Antonym:** Containment, End, slump

**Sentence:** The outbreak of measles in the community led to a mass immunization response.

### **6.AEGIS (noun): संरक्षण**

**Pronunciation:** ee.juhs

**Meaning:** the protection, backing, or support of a particular person or organization

**Synonym:** Shield, Patronage, charge

**Antonym:** Opposition, Enemy, attacks

**Sentence:** Under the aegis of the United Nations, the peace talks were initiated.

### **7.PATHOGENS (noun): रोगजनकों**

**Pronunciation:** pa.thuh.jnz

**Meaning:** microorganisms that cause disease

**Synonym:** Germs, Microbes

**Antonym:** Beneficials, Probiotics

**Sentence:** Studying how pathogens spread is essential for developing effective public health strategies.

### **8.INEXPENSIVE (adjective): सस्ता**

**Pronunciation:** in.uhk.spens.uhv

**Meaning:** not costing a lot of money

**Synonym:** Cheap, Affordable, low-cost

**Antonym:** Expensive, Costly, high

**Sentence:** She was looking for an inexpensive way to renovate her kitchen.

### **9.FATALITY (noun): विपत्ति**

**Pronunciation:** fayt.al.uh.tee

**Meaning:** an occurrence of death resulting from an accident or a disaster

**Synonym:** Mortality, Death, dead

**Antonym:** Survival, winner, victor

**Sentence:** The fatality rate of the disease indicates its severity and the need for urgent intervention.

### **10. IMBROGLIO (noun) : अव्यवस्था**

**Pronunciation:** uhm.broh.lee.oh

**Meaning:** a situation that is complicated, confusing or embarrassing, especially a political or public one

**Synonyms:** complication, problem, mess

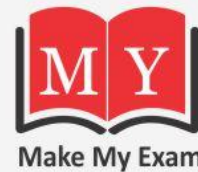
**Antonyms:** ease, peace
