



1. Poonam Gupta Appointed as RBI Deputy Governor

Dr. Poonam Gupta has been appointed as a Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) for a three-year term, succeeding Michael Patra. She is the first woman in over a decade to hold this position and brings extensive experience from her roles at the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund (IMF). Previously, she served as the Director General of the National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCAER) and was a key member of India's Economic Advisory Council. Dr. Gupta holds a Ph.D. and a Master's in Economics



from the University of Maryland, USA, and a Master's from the Delhi School of Economics.

4. Vandana Katariya Retires from International Hockey

Indian women's hockey stalwart Vandana Katariya has announced her retirement from international hockey, concluding a distinguished career that spanned over 15 years. With 320 international caps and 158 goals, she retires as India's most-capped women's player. Vandana made her senior team debut in 2009 and played a pivotal role in several of India's significant achievements, including the historic fourth-place finish at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics, where she became the first Indian woman to score a hat-trick at the Games.

5. Jacob Duffy Tops ICC T20I Bowling Rankings

New Zealand fast bowler Jacob Duffy has ascended to the top of the ICC Men's T20 International (T20I) Bowling Rankings, marking his first time achieving the number one position in any format. This milestone follows his outstanding performance in the recent five-match T20I series against Pakistan, where he claimed 13 wickets at an average of 8.38, contributing significantly to New Zealand's 4-1 series victory. Duffy's achievement makes him the first New Zealander to hold the premier T20I bowling ranking since Ish Sodhi in 2018. His



ascent in the rankings saw him surpass notable bowlers, including West Indies spinner Akeal Hosein, who previously held the top spot.

6. Sivasubramanian Ramann Appointed as New Chairperson of PFRDA

Sivasubramanian Ramann has been appointed as the new Chairperson of the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) for a five-year term. He succeeds Deepak Mohanty, who retired in March 2025. Prior to this role, Ramann served as the Chairman and Managing Director of the Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), where he played a crucial role in supporting MSMEs. A 1991-batch

The award was presented to him at his residence in Dharamshala by Nicolas De Santis, President of Gold Mercury International.
