### **1.INCONCEIVABLE (adj.): समझ से बाहर**

**Pronunciation:** in·kuhn·seev·uh·bl

**Meaning:** not capable of being imagined or grasped mentally; unbelievable.

**Synonyms:** beyond belief, unbelievable, extremely difficult to believe

**Antonyms:** believable, cogitable, conceivable

**Sentence:** She found the idea quite inconceivable.

### **2.TRANSPIRED (verb): घटित होना**

**Pronunciation:** tran·spai·uhd

**Meaning:** as in happened; to take place

**Synonyms:** happen, occur, take place

**Antonyms:** forbid, invalidate, disapprove.

**Sentence:** Exactly what transpired remains unknown.

### **3.UTTERANCE (noun): कथन**

**Pronunciation:** uh·tuh·ruhns

**Meaning:** a spoken word, statement, or vocal sound.

**Synonyms:** remark, comment, word

**Antonyms:** listening, question, quiet.

**Sentence:** The speaker had great powers of utterance.

### **4.WRITS (noun): प्रादेश**

**Pronunciation:** rits

**Meaning:** a form of written command in the name of a court or other legal authority to act, or abstain from acting, in some way.

**Synonyms:** warrants, summonses, subpoenas

**Antonyms:** evolution, increment, irreversible process.

**Sentence:** There have been at least seven writs issued against him for late payment of bills.

### **5.RECHRISTENED (verb): नामकरण**

**Pronunciation:** *rechristened*

**Meaning:** give a new name to.

**Synonyms:** renamed, relabelled, called

**Antonyms:** anonymous, faceless, foreign, ignored

**Sentence:** He rechristened Zaire the Democratic Republic of Congo.

### **6.LICIT (adj.): जायज**

**Pronunciation:** li·suht

**Meaning:** not forbidden; lawful.

**Synonyms:** legitimate, permissible, admissible

**Antonyms:** illegal, illegitimate, illicit

**Sentence:** She made some money by licit means.

### **7.GALE (noun): आंधी**

**Pronunciation:** gale

**Meaning:** a very strong wind.

**Synonyms:** storm, hurricane, windstorm

**Antonyms:** breeze, stillness, quiet

**Sentence:** It was blowing a gale outside.

### **8.SEMINAL (adj.): प्रभावपूर्ण**

**Pronunciation:** seh·muh·nuhl

**Meaning:** (of a work, event, moment, or figure) strongly influencing later developments.

**Synonyms:** influential, formative, pioneering

**Antonyms:** small, little, minor

**Sentence:** His book on social policy proved to be seminal.

### **9.COMPORT (verb): सहमत होना**

**Pronunciation:** comport

**Meaning:** accord with; agree with.

**Synonyms:** correspond, conform, coincide

**Antonyms:** contradict, differ (from), disagree (with)

**Sentence:** His statement did not comport with the facts.

### **10.TAINTING (verb): दूषित**

**Pronunciation:** taynt·uhng

**Meaning:** contaminate or pollute (something).

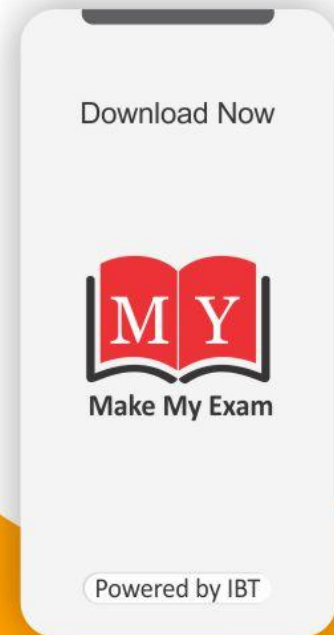
**Synonyms:** contaminate, pollute, befouling

**Antonyms:** decontaminating, purifying, filtering

**Sentence:** Smog has long tainted the air of the city, making it difficult to breathe.

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
