### **1.INGRAINED (adjective) – अंतर्निहित, स्थायी**

**Pronunciation:** in·greind

**Meaning:** firmly fixed or established

**Synonyms:** entrenched, established, fixed, inbred, implanted

**Antonyms:** transient, superficial

**Usage:** The idea of doing our duty is deeply ingrained in most people.

### **2.RIGHTEOUSNESS (noun) – सच्चाई, निष्कपटता**

**Pronunciation:** rai·chus·nus

**Meaning:** the quality of being morally right or justifiable

**Synonyms:** goodness, rectitude, virtuousness, uprightness, decency, integrity, worthiness

**Antonyms:** infamy, dishonesty

**Usage:** Both sides in the dispute have been adopting a tone of moral righteousness.

### **3.LIAISE (verb) - मिलकर काम करना**

**Pronunciation:** li·eiz

**Meaning:** cooperate on a matter of mutual concern

**Synonyms:** cooperate, collaborate, coordinate, synchronize, assist

**Antonyms:** counteract, negate, counterwork

**Usage:** Our head office will liaise with the suppliers to ensure delivery.

### **4.CONVINCE (verb) - मनाना**

**Pronunciation:** kun·vins

**Meaning:** cause someone to do or believe something

**Synonyms:** persuade, induce, assure, satisfy, reassure

**Antonyms:** dissuade, confuse, dissatisfy

**Usage:** I was convinced by his explanation.

### **5.PREREQUISITE (noun) – शर्त, आधार**

**Pronunciation:** pri·rik·wizit

**Meaning:** a thing that is required as a prior condition for something else to happen or exist

**Synonyms:** precondition, essential, requirement, qualification, requisite

**Antonyms:** nonessential, unnecessary, extra

**Usage:** Having good communication skill is a prerequisite for qualifying the interview.

### 6.SPRUCE (verb) - स्वच्छ और सुंदर बनाना

**Pronunciation:** sproos

**Meaning:** to make something clean or neat

**Synonyms:** cleanse, wash, purify, neatened, refine

**Antonyms:** pollute, adulterate, worsen

**Usage:** The fund will be used to spruce up historic buildings.



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### 7.VAIN (adjective) – व्यर्थ

**Pronunciation:** vein

**Meaning:** producing no result

**Synonyms:** futile, useless, worthless, nugatory, fruitless

**Antonyms:** successful, productive, useful

**Usage:** The toddler's attempt to reach the cookie jar on the counter was in vain.

### 8.ABSOLUTION (noun) - मुक्ति

**Pronunciation:** ab·suh·loo·shn

**Meaning:** formal release from guilt, obligation, or punishment

**Synonyms:** forgiveness, exoneration, remission, dispensation, pardoning

**Antonym:** punishment

**Usage:** The priest heard her confession and granted absolution.

### 9.IMPERATIVE (adjective) – अनिवार्य

**Pronunciation:** uhm·peh·ruh·tuhv

**Meaning:** of vital importance

**Synonyms:** vital, crucial, critical, essential, necessary, indispensable, exigent

**Antonyms:** unimportant, optional, inessential

**Usage:** It is imperative for your recovery to continue the treatment for at least two months.

### 10. TUSSELE (noun) – संघर्ष

**Pronunciation:** tuh·sl

**Meaning:** fight or struggle

**Synonyms:** scuffle, fight, struggle, skirmish, brawl, scrimmage

**Antonyms:** harmony, peace, accord

**Usage:** Because they like to tussle, the lion cubs spend a good part of their day wrestling each other.

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
