

# 1.SHRINE (noun): पवित्र स्थान

Pronunciation: shrine
Meaning: a place regarded as holy because of its associations with a divinity or a sacred person or relic, marked by a building or other construction.
Synonyms: holy place, temple, church
Antonyms: public place, apartment, city
Sentence: The medieval pilgrim route to the <u>shrine</u> of St. James.

### 2.EVINCE (verb): जताना

Pronunciation: uh•vinsMeaning: reveal the presence of (a quality or feeling).Synonyms: reveal, show, make clearAntonyms: conceal, cover, hideSentence: His letters evince the excitement he felt at undertaking this journey.

## 3.INEXORABLE (adj.) : निष्ठुर

Pronunciation: uhn•ek•suh•ruh•bl
Meaning: impossible to stop or prevent.
Synonyms: relentless, unstoppable, unavoidable
Antonyms: hesitant, halted, dubious
Sentence: During 1939 the approach of war seemed <u>inexorable</u>.

### 4.ONSLAUGHT (noun) : हमला

Pronunciation: awn•slawtMeaning: a fierce or destructive attack.Synonyms: assault, attack, offensiveAntonyms: defense, guard, shieldSentence: Our army tried to withstand the enemy <u>onslaught</u>.

# 5.VIVACITY (noun) : चुस्ती

Pronunciation: vuh•va•suh•tee
Meaning: (especially in a woman) the quality of being attractively lively and animated.
Synonyms: ebullience, sparkle, spirit
Antonyms: indolence, laziness, listlessness
Sentence: He was struck by her <u>vivacity</u>, humor, and charm.



# 6.SPUR (noun) : प्रेरणा

Pronunciation: spuhMeaning: a thing that prompts or encourages someone; an incentive.Synonyms: stimulus, incentive, encouragementAntonyms: disincentive, discouragementSentence: Profit was both the <u>spur</u> and the reward of the enterprise.

## 7.INFIDEL (noun) : नास्तिक

Pronunciation: in•fuh•dl
Meaning: a person who does not believe in religion or who adheres to a religion other than one's own.
Synonyms: nonbeliever, heathen, pagan
Antonyms: believer, conformer, conformist
Sentence: They wanted to secure the Holy Places from the <u>infidel</u>.

## 8.BELEAGUER (verb) : धेरा डालना

Pronunciation: buh•lee•guhMeaning: lay siege to (a place); besiege.Synonyms: besieged, under siege, blockadedAntonyms: free, liberateSentence: Our leaders decided to beleaguer the city.

#### 9.MENACE (verb) : खतरा

Pronunciation: meh•nuhsMeaning: threaten, especially in a malignant or hostile manner.Synonyms: threaten, scare, imperilAntonyms: guard, protect, saveSentence: Africa's elephants are still menaced by poaching.

# 10.THWART (verb) : बिगाड़ना

Pronunciation: thvawtMeaning: prevent (someone) from accomplishing something.Synonyms: foil, baffle, hinderAntonyms: nurture, promote, assistSentence: I don't think that will <u>thwart</u> our purposes.
