

1. SCUTTLE (verb) : तीव्र गति

Pronunciation: skuh•tl

Meaning: run hurriedly or furtively with short quick steps.

Synonyms: scamper, scurry, scramble **Antonyms:** crawl, creep, slowness

Sentence: A mouse <u>scuttled</u> across the floor.

2. CHASTISE (verb) : दंड देना

Pronunciation: chas tise

Meaning: rebuke or reprimand severely.

Synonyms: scold, upbraid, berate **Antonyms:** excuse, pardon, spare

Sentence: He chastised his colleagues for their laziness.

3. EGRESS (noun) : निकास

Pronunciation: ē- gres

Meaning: the action of going out of or leaving a place.

Synonyms: departure, leaving, exit **Antonyms:** entrance, entry, ingress

Sentence: The only <u>egress</u> from the nightclub was a dark, narrow stairway to the street

below.

4. AMENABLE (adj.) : वश्य

Pronunciation: uh•mee•nuh•bl

Meaning: (of a person) open and responsive to suggestion; easily persuaded or controlled.

Synonyms: compliant, acquiescent, biddable **Antonyms:** disinclined, unamenable, unwilling

Sentence: Parents who have had easy babies and <u>amenable</u> children.

5. HILARITY (noun) : आनंद

Pronunciation: huh-la-ruh-tee

Meaning: extreme amusement, especially when expressed by laughter.

Synonyms: amusement, mirth, laughter

Antonyms: depression, despondence, sorrow

Sentence: His incredulous expression was the cause of much <u>hilarity</u>.

6.TUMBLE (verb) : लुढ़क

Pronunciation: tuhm•bl

Meaning: (typically of a person) fall suddenly, clumsily, or headlong.

Synonyms: fall (over), fall down, topple over **Antonyms:** get up, rise, stand (up), uprise

Sentence: She pitched forward, tumbling down the remaining stairs.

7. SPARSE (adj.): विरल

Pronunciation: spaas

Meaning: thinly dispersed or scattered. Synonyms: scanty, scant, scattered Antonyms: abundant, ample, bountiful

Sentence: Many slopes are rock fields with sparse vegetation.

8. GROPE (verb) : अंधे की तरह खोजना

Pronunciation: 'grop

Meaning: feel about or search blindly or uncertainly with the hands.

Synonyms: fumble, scrabble, search **Antonyms:** succeed, stifle, disengage

Sentence: She got up and <u>groped</u> for her spectacles.

9. CONUNDRUM (noun) : पहेली

Pronunciation: kuh•nuhn•druhm

Meaning: a confusing and difficult problem or question. **Synonyms:** problem, difficult question, vexed question

Antonyms: answer, axiom, explanation

Sentence: This is not merely a curious <u>conundrum</u>.

10. VEXED (adj.) : झगड़े का

Pronunciation: vekst

Meaning: (of a problem or issue) difficult and much-debated; problematic.


Synonyms: disputed, contested, contentious

Antonyms: delighted, pleased, placid

Sentence: Ministers have begun work on the <u>vexed</u> issue of economic union.
