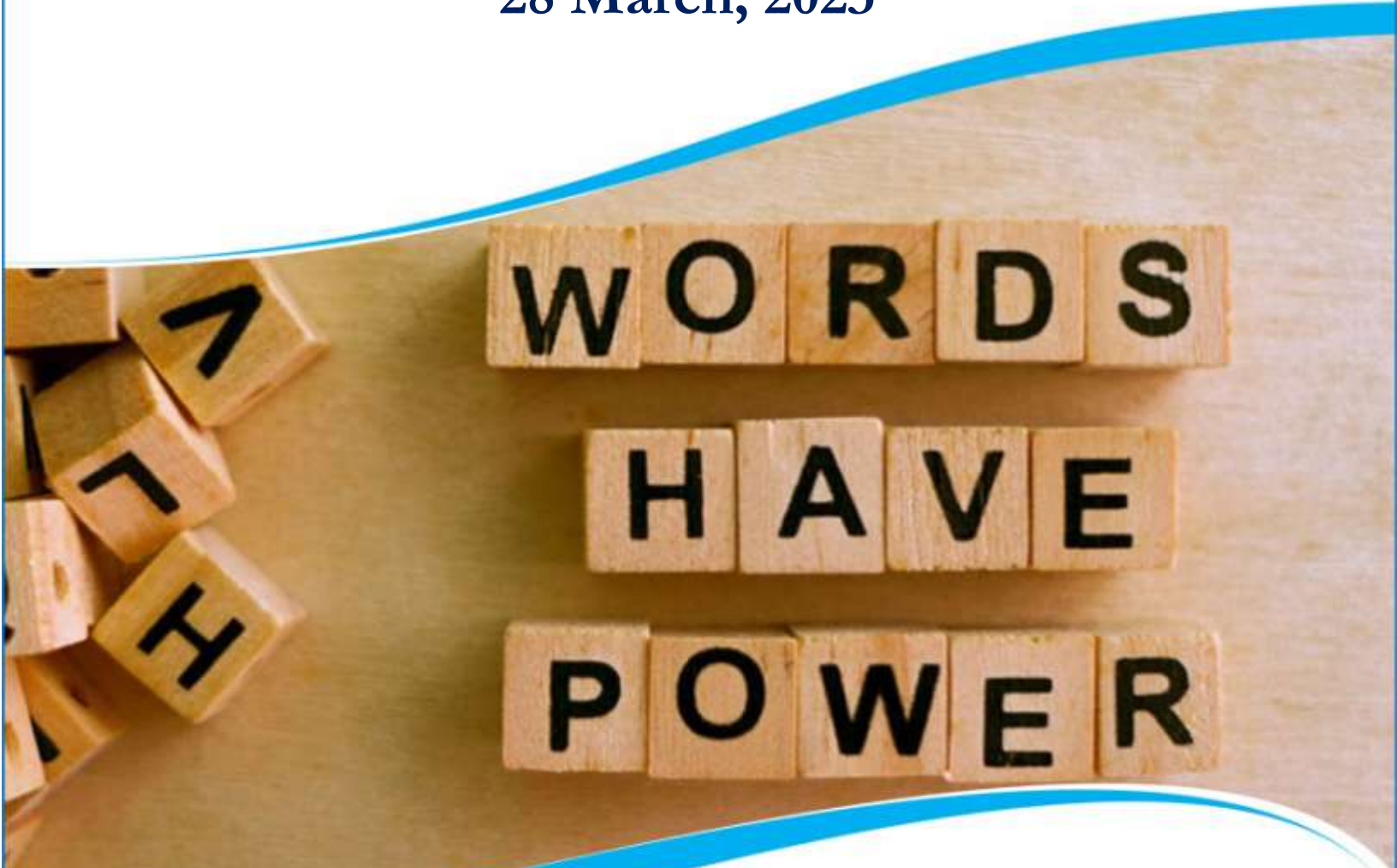

### 1. EFFETE (adj.) : अशक्त

**Pronunciation:** uh·feet

**Meaning:** (of a person) affected, overrefined, and ineffectual.

**Synonyms:** affected, over-refined, ineffectual

**Antonyms:** undecadent, determined, mettlesome

**Sentence:** People said the aristocracy was effete.

### 2. SEDATE (adj.) : गंभीर

**Pronunciation:** suh·dayt

**Meaning:** calm, dignified, and unhurried.

**Synonyms:** calm, tranquil, placid

**Antonyms:** facetious, kittenish, ludic

**Sentence:** The wedding was instead a sedate occasion.

### 3. PERPETUITY (noun) : अनंत काल

**Pronunciation:** puh·puh·tyoo·uh·tee

**Meaning:** the state or quality of lasting forever.

**Synonyms:** eternity, everlasting, limitless

**Antonyms:** ephemerality, impermanence, temporariness

**Sentence:** These lands were granted to our family in perpetuity.

### 4. FIAT (noun) : हुक्मनामा

**Pronunciation:** FIAT

**Meaning:** a formal authorization or proposition; a decree.

**Synonyms:** decree, edict, order

**Antonyms:** denial, disapproval, opposition

**Sentence:** Prices have been fixed by government fiat.

### 5. ADDUCED (verb) : प्रस्तुत करना

**Pronunciation:** uh·dyoost

**Meaning:** cite as evidence.

**Synonyms:** cite, instance, mention

**Antonyms:** disprove, affirm, hide

**Sentence:** We can adduce evidence to support the claim.

**6. EMINENCE (noun) : श्रेष्ठता**

**Pronunciation:** eh·muh·nuhns

**Meaning:** fame or recognized superiority, especially within a particular sphere or profession.

**Synonyms:** renown, pre-eminence, notability

**Antonyms:** inferiority, mediocrity, obscureness

**Sentence:** Beveridge was a man of great eminence.

**7. FORTUITOUS (adj.) : आकस्मिक**

**Pronunciation:** faw·tyoo·uh·tuhs

**Meaning:** happening by accident or chance rather than design.

**Synonyms:** chance, unexpected, unanticipated

**Antonyms:** hapless, intentional, planned

**Sentence:** The similarity between the paintings may not be simply fortuitous.

**8. INSURRECTION (noun) : विद्रोह**

**Pronunciation:** in·suh·rek·shn

**Meaning:** a violent uprising against an authority or government.

**Synonyms:** rebellion, revolt, uprising

**Antonyms:** law, peace, order

**Sentence:** The insurrection was savagely put down.

**9. MOSEY (verb) : चला जाना**

**Pronunciation:** moh·zee

**Meaning:** walk or move in a leisurely manner.

**Synonyms:** amble, perambulate, ramble

**Antonyms:** hurry, leave, rush

**Sentence:** I'll just mosey down to the beach for a while.

**10. FREEBIE (noun) : मुफ्त**

**Pronunciation:** free·bee

**Meaning:** a thing given free of charge.

**Synonyms:** bequest, favor, present

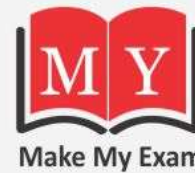
**Antonyms:** bribe, douceur
