### 1. BRIO (noun) – चुस्ती

**Pronunciation:** bree·ow

**Meaning:** vigor or vivacity of style or performance

**Synonyms:** vigor, vivacity, gusto, verve, zest, sparkle, dash

**Antonyms:** lethargy, inertia, inactivity

**Usage:** Michele is an elderly woman whose brio astounds everyone.

### 2. KUDOS (noun) – यश

**Pronunciation:** kyoo·dos

**Meaning:** praise and honor received for an achievement

**Synonyms:** prestige, cachet, glory, honor, status, standing, distinction

**Antonyms:** obscurity, infamy, disrespect

**Usage:** The person who wrote that wonderful speech is worthy of kudos.

### 3. TEMPERATE (adjective) – संयम

**Pronunciation:** tem·puh·ruht

**Meaning:** showing self-restraint

**Synonyms:** restrained, moderate, controlled, disciplined, abstinent

**Antonyms:** intemperate, immoderate

**Usage:** He is temperate in his habits.

### 4. DESERT (verb) - छोड़ देना

**Pronunciation:** di·zert

**Meaning:** leave a place, causing it to appear empty

**Synonyms:** abandon, leave, renounce, forsake, abscond

**Antonyms:** remain, return, stay

**Usage:** The birds have deserted their nest.

### 5. RECKLESS (adjective) – लापरवाह

**Pronunciation:** rek·lus

**Meaning:** heedless of danger or the consequences of one's actions

**Synonyms:** rash, careless, heedless, unheeding, inattentive, precipitous, impetuous, impulsive

**Antonyms:** careful, cautious, prudent

**Usage:** Tom showed reckless disregard for Mary's feelings.

### 6.EMANCIPATION (noun) – मुक्ति

**Pronunciation:** uh·man·suh·pei·shn

**Meaning:** the fact or process of being set free from legal, social, or political restrictions

**Synonyms:** liberation, release, freedom, independence, discharge

**Antonyms:** enslavement, slavery, imprisonment

**Usage:** After emancipation, the former slave was able to make choices about where he would live and work.

### 7.ACCOUNTABLE (adjective) – उत्तरदायी, जिम्मेदार

**Pronunciation:** uh·kawn·tuh·bl

**Meaning:** required or expected to justify actions or decisions

**Synonyms:** responsible, answerable, liable, culpable, obligated

**Antonym:** unaccountable, irresponsible, blameless

**Usage:** When parents aren't around to hold their kids accountable for negative behaviors, the kids run wild.

### 8.ARCHAIC (adjective) – प्राचीन, पुरातन

**Pronunciation:** aar·ke·ik

**Meaning:** very old or old-fashioned

**Synonyms:** obsolete, obsolescent, anachronistic, old-fashioned, outmoded

**Antonyms:** new, modern, contemporary

**Usage:** The original Model of Ford car is considered archaic when compared to modern vehicles.

### 9.NUMEROUS (adjective) – अनेक, बहुसंख्यक

**Pronunciation:** nyoo·mrus

**Meaning:** great in number

**Synonyms:** many, countless, innumerable, several

**Antonym:** few, less, some

**Usage:** Numerous attempts have been made to hide the truth.

### 10.ENVOY (noun) – दूत, प्रतिनिधि

**Pronunciation:** en·voi

**Meaning:** a messenger or representative

**Synonyms:** delegate, diplomat, representative, agent, ambassador, messenger

**Antonym:** receiver

**Usage:** The king sent his envoy to discuss his daughter's marriage to his rival's son.
