

1. EUPHORIA (noun): उत्साह

Pronunciation: eu pho ri a

Meaning: a feeling or state of intense excitement and happiness.

Synonyms: felicity, elation, joyousness

Antonyms: misery, depression

Sentence: He was still in a state of euphoria hours after the match had finished.

2. SIMPLIFY (verb): सरल करना

Pronunciation: sim-pli-fy

Meaning: make (something) simpler or easier to do or understand.

Synonyms: clarify, untangle, make plainer **Antonyms:** complicate, problematize, confuse

Sentence: you need to <u>simplify</u> the plot for younger children.

3. VERNAL (adj): नव

Pronunciation: ver•nal

Meaning: fresh or new like the spring; youthful.

Synonyms: fresh, recent, youthful **Antonyms:** old, aged, immemorial

Sentence: He wants to write big, important, unforgettable, unusual books, whose sentences

zing with vernal energy.

4. PAINSTAKING (adj): श्रमसाध्य

Pronunciation: pains • tak • ing

Meaning: done with or employing great care and thoroughness.

Synonyms: careful, meticulous, thorough **Antonyms:** careless, negligent, slapdash **Sentence:** he is a gentle, <u>painstaking</u> man.

5. SOLITARY (adj): अकेला

Pronunciation: sol•i•tar•y

Meaning: done or existing alone.

Synonyms: lonely, unsociable, companionless

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Antonyms: sociable, accompanied **Sentence:** They live in a <u>solitary</u> spot

6. EVANESCE (verb): गायब होना

Pronunciation: ev•a•nesce

Meaning: pass out of sight, memory, or existence.

Synonyms: disappear, fade, vanish **Antonyms:** appear, emerge, show up

Sentence: As you fly in a plane, the ground gradually <u>evanesces</u>.

7. SNIVEL (verb): रिरियाहट

Pronunciation: snivel

Meaning: cry and sniff in a feeble or fretful way.

Synonyms: sniffle, cry, weep **Antonyms:** laugh, giggle, cackle

Sentence: Kate started to snivel, looking sad and stunned.

8. CONVALESCE (verb): अच्छा हो जाना

Pronunciation: con•va•lesce

Meaning: recover one's health and strength over a period of time after an illness or

operation.

Synonyms: recuperate, get better, recover **Antonyms:** deteriorate, weaken, spoil

Sentence: He is <u>convalescing</u> from his leg injuries.

9. SUSTAIN (verb): बनाए रखना

Pronunciation: sus•tain

Meaning: strengthen or support physically or mentally.

Synonyms: support, assist, encourage

Antonyms: torment, plague

Sentence: It's hard for the team to <u>sustain</u> their momentum for 90 minutes.

10. FIB (noun): मिथ्या

Pronunciation: fib

Meaning: a lie, typically an unimportant one.


Synonyms: lie, untruth, falsehood

Antonyms: truth, fact

Sentence: why did you tell him such a dreadful <u>fib</u>?

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
