- This growth is a testament to India's increasing presence in the global electronics market, with exports of electronic goods such as smartphones, laptops, and televisions driving the surge.
- The top export destinations for Indian electronics include the US, Saudi Arabia, France, Bangladesh, and Sri Lanka, with these countries accounting for a significant share of India's electronics exports.


- Pant was acquired by LSG for a staggering INR 27 crore, making him the most expensive player in the IPL, and now he's poised to lead the team.
