1. NEBULOUS (adjective) – ध्ंधला; अस्पष्ट

Pronunciation: neb-yu-lus

Meaning: in the form of a cloud or haze; (of a concept) vague or ill-defined **Synonyms**: indistinct, indefinite, unclear, hazy, cloudy, fuzzy; vague, ill-defined

Antonyms: clear; well defined

Usage:

Scientists are not certain why nebulous gas balls rotate around the planet.

The very concept of existence of God is <u>nebulous</u> to all.

2. HAG (noun) – डायन, चुड़ैल

Pronunciation: hag

Meaning: a witch; an ugly old woman

Synonyms: crone, gorgon **Antonyms**: sylphlike

Usage: In that old house, a fat hag lives alone.

3. KUDOS (noun) – प्रसिद्धि, गौरव

Pronunciation: kyoo-dos

Meaning: praise and honour received for an achievement

Synonyms: prestige, cachet, glory, honour, status

Antonyms: obscurity, infamy

Usage: She wanted <u>kudos</u> rather than profit.

4. UNDERPRIVILEGED (adjective) – ज़रूरतमंद, ग्रीब, अभावग्रस्त

Pronunciation: un-duh-privi-lijd

Meaning: (of a person) not enjoying the same standard of living or rights as the majority of people in a society

Synonyms: needy, deprived, disadvantaged, needful, poor, destitute

Antonyms: privileged, wealthy, well off

Usage: The underprivileged children need special support.

5. SPRUCE (adjective, verb) – बना-ठना, साफ-सुथरा; सजाना

Pronunciation: sproos

Meaning: neat in dress and appearance; make someone or something smarter or tidier

Synonyms: well groomed, well dressed, besuited; tidy up, do up

Antonyms: scruffy, untidy, dishevelled


Usage:

Angela was a very <u>spruce</u> and tidy person. (adjective)
The fund will be used to <u>spruce</u> up historic buildings. (verb)

6. CONCOMITANT (adjective) – सहवर्ती, सहचारी

Pronunciation: kun-komi-t(u)nt

Meaning: naturally accompanying or associated **Synonyms**: collateral, related, connected, linked

Antonym: unrelated

Usage: She loved travel, with all its concomitant worries.

7. VICINITY (noun) - आस-पडोस

Pronunciation: visi-niti

Meaning: the area near or surrounding a particular place

Synonyms: neighbourhood, locality, locale

Usage: The stolen car was found in the <u>vicinity</u> of the railway station.

8. REVILE (verb) – बुरा-भला कहना, धिक्कारना

Pronunciation: ri-va-il

Meaning: criticize in an abusive or angrily insulting manner

Synonyms: censure, condemn **Antonyms**: praise, extol

Usage: They feared that he would <u>revile</u> them if they displeased him.

9. KINDLE (verb) – प्रज्वलित करना

Pronunciation: kind(u)l

Meaning: set something on fire; arouse or inspire an emotion or feeling

Synonyms: light, ignite; rouse, arouse, wake, waken, awaken, quicken, stimulate

Antonyms: douse, extinguish, put out

Usage:

The wet wood wouldn't <u>kindle</u> easily. A love for art was kindled in me.

10. ADDLE (verb) – घबरा देना; आश्चर्यचकित करना

Pronunciation: ad(u)l

Meaning: make (someone) unable to think clearly

Synonyms: muddled, confused, fuddled, befuddled, bewildered, dazed

Usage: I suppose the shock had addled his poor old brain.


