

1. COVETED (VERB): लोभ करना

Pronunciation: kuh·vuht·uhd

Meaning: strongly desired by many.

Synonyms: Crave, Desire **Antonyms:** Hate, Dislike

Sentence: She always coveted power but never quite achieved it.

2. APOCALYPSE (NOUN): कयामत

Pronunciation: uh·paw·kuh·luhps

Meaning: a very serious event resulting in great destruction and change.

Synonyms: Holocaust, Devastation **Antonyms:** Miracle, Happiness

Sentence: Many religious groups believe an apocalypse will one day terminate the

lives of all sinners.

3. FRACTIOUS (ADJECTIVE): झगड़ालू

Pronunciation: fra·kshuhs

Meaning: irritable and quarrelsome. **Synonyms:** Grumpy, Ill-Mannered **Antonyms:** Affable, Obedient

Sentence: Nandini was in a fractious mood.

4. INDUCE (VERB): प्रेरित करना

Pronunciation: uhn·dyoos

Meaning: persuade someone to do something.

Synonyms: Convince, Inspire **Antonyms:** Dissuade, Discourage

Sentence: They will induce labour to avoid complications.

5. UNTENABLE (ADJECTIVE): अस्थिर

Pronunciation: uhn·teh·nuh·bl

Meaning: incapable of being defended. **Synonyms:** Unarguable, Unjustifiable

Antonyms: Moderate, Rational

Sentence: Three years of drought have made the supply situation untenable.

6. PERSUADED (VERB): आश्वस्त

Pronunciation: puh·svayd·uhd

Meaning: to prevail on (a person) to do something.

Synonyms: Coax, Convince

Antonyms: Discourage, Dissuade

Sentence: He would not listen to anyone who tried to persuade him to stay at home.

7. EXACTED (ADJECTIVE): सटीक

Pronunciation: uhg·zakt·uhd Meaning: correct; accurate. Synonyms: Sanctioned, Imposed Antonyms: Fuzzy, Uncertain

Sentence: They would not rest until they had exacted revenge.

8. HELM (NOUN): संचालन

Pronunciation: helm

Meaning: wheel or handle used to control the boat.

Synonyms: Tiller, Rudder **Antonyms:** Walk, Repel

Sentence: During the crisis, the chief firefighter took the helm and got everyone to

safety quickly.

9. WOBBLING (VERB): डगमगाना

Pronunciation: vaw·buhl·uhng

Meaning: to move unsteadily from side to side.

Synonyms: Jiggle, See-Saw **Antonyms:** Steady, Stabilize

Sentence: The boy was wobbling along on his bicycle.

10. AWRY (ADJECTIVE, ADVERB): टेढ़ा

Pronunciation: uh·rai


Meaning: untidy.

Synonyms: Amis, Wrong **Antonyms:** Straigh, Even

Sentence: I feel that he is totally awry in his comments.
