

3. NASA Welcomes Bangladesh as the Newest Artemis Accords Signatory

On April 8, 2025, Bangladesh became the 54th nation to sign the Artemis Accords, committing to the peaceful and cooperative exploration of space. The signing ceremony took place in Dhaka, with Bangladesh's Secretary of Defense, Ashraf Uddin, signing on behalf of the country. NASA's acting Administrator, Janet Petro, welcomed Bangladesh's participation, emphasizing the nation's role in shaping the







future of space exploration. The Artemis Accords, established in 2020, outline principles for safe and sustainable space activities among signatory nations.

4. Werner Herzog to Receive Golden Lion at Venice Festival

Renowned German filmmaker Werner Herzog will be honored with the Golden Lion for Lifetime Achievement at the 82nd Venice International Film Festival, scheduled from August 27 to September 6, 2025. Herzog, aged 81, has an extensive career spanning over six decades, during which he has directed, produced, and written approximately 70 films, including notable works like "Fitzcarraldo" and "Grizzly Man." In addition to his filmmaking endeavors, he has accumulated more than 30 acting credits in film and television.

5. India Becomes World's Third Largest Solar and Wind Power Generator, Surpassing Germany

India has become the world's third-largest generator of electricity from solar and wind energy, surpassing Germany. This achievement marks a significant milestone in India's transition to renewable energy and its commitment to sustainable development. According to recent data, wind and solar now contribute to about 10% of the country's total electricity generation. The growth is attributed to strong policy support, large-scale installations, and technological



advancements. India now trails only China and the United States in renewable energy output from these sources. This progress reinforces India's global standing in clean energy leadership and its efforts to combat climate change.

- Renewable Energy Capacity: India's non-fossil fuel-based energy capacity reached 217.62 GW, with solar energy accounting for 47% of the installed renewable capacity.
- **Record Additions:** In 2024, India added a record 24.5 GW of solar capacity and 3.4 GW of wind capacity, driven by government incentives and policy reforms.
- **Global Ranking:** India now ranks third globally in wind and solar energy production, with wind and solar accounting for 10% of the country's electricity generation and 15% globally.
- Renewable Energy Potential: India's renewable energy potential stands at approximately 21 lakh MW, with wind power accounting for 55% of this potential.
- **Government Initiatives:** The Indian government has implemented policies to boost renewable energy adoption, including tax incentives, subsidies for solar panel manufacturers, and targets for renewable capacity additions.
- **Future Goals:** India aims to achieve 500 GW of non-fossil fuel-based energy by 2030 and enhance domestic manufacturing of solar and wind technologies to reduce dependence on imports.

10. Ram Sahay Pandey Folk Dancer passed away

Renowned Rai folk dancer Ram Sahay Pandey passed away on April 8, 2025, at the age of 92 in Sagar district, Madhya Pradesh, following a prolonged illness. Born on March 11, 1933, in Maddhar Patha village, Pandey dedicated his life to popularizing the Rai dance, a traditional art form of the Bundelkhand region. Over his six-decade-long career, he performed in more than 100 events across 18 countries, earning international acclaim. In recognition of his significant contributions to the arts, he



was awarded the Padma Shri, India's fourth-highest civilian honor, in 2022. Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Mohan Yadav expressed deep sorrow over Pandey's demise, highlighting his role in bringing global recognition to Bundelkhand's folk art. Pandey is survived by his wife and son.
