





1. Yash Vir Singh wins javelin gold at Indian Open Athletics 2025

Yashvir Singh clinched the gold medal in the men's javelin throw at the 2025 IndianOpen Athletics Championships, showcasing his exceptional talent. The Rajasthan athlete achieved a remarkable throw of 82.13 meters, surpassing his previous personal best and asserting his dominance in the field. This victory adds to his impressive track record,



including breaking Neeraj Chopra's U20 record with a 78.68-meter throw in 2021 . Singh's consistent performances highlight his potential to represent India on international platforms. His dedication and skill continue to inspire upcoming athletes in the country.

2. Shreyas Iyer Named ICC Men's Player of March 2025

Shreyas Iyer has been named the ICC Men's Player of the Month for March 2025, recognizing his pivotal role in India's victorious ICC Champions Trophy campaign.

Iyer amassed 243 runs across five matches, averaging 48.60, and emerged as India's top scorer in the tournament. His standout performances included a crucial 79 against New Zealand in the group stage and vital contributions of 45 and 48 in the semi-final and final, respectively, underscoring his consistency under pressure. This accolade marks a significant milestone in Iyer's career, highlighting his importance to India's middle-order lineup. Expressing his elation, Iyer stated he was



"over the moon" after securing his first ICC trophy with the national team.

Lithuania's Mykolas Alekna shattered his own discus world record with a monumental throw of 75.56 meters at the Oklahoma Throws Series on April 13, 2025. This historic feat made him the first athlete to surpass the 75-meter mark in men's discus throw. Alekna's previous record of 74.35 meters, set at the same venue in 2024, was eclipsed twice during the competition—first with a 74.89-meter throw, followed by the record-breaking 75.56-meter effort. The event saw exceptional performances including Australia's Matthew Danny's 74.78 met



performances, including Australia's Matthew Denny's 74.78-meter throw, which also surpassed the previous world record.

4. Mirabai Chanu Appointed Chairperson of IWLF Athletes Commission

Olympic silver medallist Mirabai Chanu has been unanimously elected as the Chairperson of the Indian Weightlifting Federation's (IWLF) Athletes Commission on April 15, 2025. Expressing her gratitude, Chanu thanked the IWLF and its president Sahdev Yadav for their trust, stating that representing the voice of fellow weightlifters is a matter of great pride for her. She pledged to take her responsibilities seriously and work towards amplifying athletes' perspectives across all key channels to ensure a focused

5. Saurabh Chaudhary Wins Bronze in 10m Air Pistol At ISSF World Cup 2025

Saurabh Chaudhary secured a bronze medal in the men's 10m air pistol event at the 2025 ISSF World Cup in Lima, Peru, marking his first individual international podium finish since 2022. The 22-year-old shooter from Uttar Pradesh scored 219.1 points in the final, finishing behind China's Hu Kai, who clinched gold with 246.4 points, and Brazil's Felipe Almeida Wu, who took silver with 241.0 points. Chaudhary led early in the final but slipped in the later stages, while his cousin Varun Tomar narrowly missed



the podium, finishing fourth. This medal adds to Chaudhary's recent success, including a mixed team bronze with Suruchi Singh at the Buenos Aires World Cup. His performance in Lima signifies a strong comeback to the international shooting circuit.
