

1.INDECIPHERABLE (adj.) : अस्पष्ट

Pronunciation: in · duh · sai · fuh · ruh · bl

Meaning: not able to be read or understood.

Synonyms: hard to read, unreadable, indiscernible

Antonyms: decipherable, readable

Sentence: There was an <u>indecipherable</u> message on the answering machine.

2.MORTGAGING (verb): गिरवी

Pronunciation: maw guhj uhng

Meaning: convey (a property) to a creditor as security on a loan.

Synonyms: engaging, pledging, trothing

Antonyms: asset, cash, credit

Sentence: The report explains how governments are <u>mortgaging</u> their nations' futures.

3.VERITABLE (adj.) : सच्चा

Pronunciation: veh·ruh·tuh·bl

Meaning: formal true or real —used to emphasize a description (often to qualify a

metaphor)

Synonyms: authentic, genuine, real **Antonyms:** doubtful, dubious, equivocal

Sentence: The area is a veritable paradise for those who love walking

4.CONSONANCE (noun) : समझौता

Pronunciation: kawn·suh·nuhns

Meaning: agreement or compatibility between opinions or actions.

Synonyms: agreement, concord, accord

Antonyms: discordance, disproportion, disunity

Sentence: These results are in <u>consonance</u> with human experiences.

5.REVANCHISM (noun) : प्रतिशोध

Pronunciation: revanchism

Meaning: a policy of seeking to retaliate, especially to recover lost territory.

Synonyms: revenge, vengeance, reprisal **Antonyms:** forgiveness, pardon, sympathy

Sentence: But we also know that <u>revanchism</u> is never-ending.

6.RESPLENDENT (adj.) : उत्कृष्ट

Pronunciation: ruh·splen·dnt

Meaning: attractive and impressive through being richly colorful or sumptuous.

Synonyms: splendid, magnificent, brilliant

Antonyms: unappealing, unappetizing, unpleasant

Sentence: She looked <u>resplendent</u> in her green evening gown.

7.FLIMFLAM (noun) : बकवास

Pronunciation: flimflam

Meaning: nonsensical or insincere talk. **Synonyms:** balderdash, baloney, idiocy **Antonyms:** reasonableness, sensibleness

Sentence: I was sick of his intellectual flimflam.

8.FIAT (noun) : ह्क्मनामा

Pronunciation: fiat

Meaning: a formal authorization or proposition; a decree.

Synonyms: decree, edict, order

Antonyms: allow, permit, decriminalize

Sentence: Prices have been fixed by government <u>fiat</u>.

9.INSURRECTION (noun) : विद्रोह

Pronunciation: in · suh · rek · shn

Meaning: a violent uprising against an authority or government.

Synonyms: rebellion, revolt, uprising

Antonyms: law, peace, order

Sentence: The <u>insurrection</u> was savagely put down.

10.FREEBIE (noun): मुफ्त

Pronunciation: free bee

Meaning: a thing given free of charge. **Synonyms:** bequest, favor, present

Antonyms: bribe, douceur

Sentence: The journalists were all given a <u>freebie</u> lunch.
