President Murmu Gets Honorary Doctorate in Slovakia

1. President Murmu Gets Honorary Doctorate in Slovakia

President Droupadi Murmu has been conferred with an honorary doctorate by Constantine The Philosopher University in Nitra, Slovakia, during the final day of her four-day state visit to Slovakia and Portugal. This prestigious recognition celebrates her distinguished career in public service, her advocacy for social justice and inclusion, and her contributions to education, women's empowerment, and the preservation of cultural and linguistic diversity . She emphasized the importance of education in personal and national development, highlighting India's commitment to fostering a culture of innovation and global collaboration through initiatives like the National Education Policy .

- **Honorary Doctorate:** President Murmu was conferred with a Doctorate Honoris Causa degree by Slovakia's Constantine Philosopher University, recognizing her exceptional contributions to public service, social justice, and education.
- **First Visit in 29 Years:** This visit marks the first by an Indian president to Slovakia in nearly three decades, highlighting growing diplomatic connections

between the two nations. President Murmu arrived in Slovakia at the invitation of Slovakian President Peter Pellegrini.

- **Recognition of Contributions:** The university awarded President Murmu the honorary degree for her work in public service and governance, advocacy for social justice and inclusion, contributions to education, women's empowerment, and preservation and promotion of cultural and linguistic diversity.
- **Importance of Education:** President Murmu emphasized the transformative power of education in reducing societal inequalities, stating that "education is a means not only for individual empowerment but for national development as well."
- **Historic Significance:** The ceremony was held at Nitra, a historic city in Slovakia, and President Murmu expressed her gratitude to the university for the recognition, highlighting the role of education in neutralizing societal inequities.

2. Madhya Pradesh Declares New Wildlife Sanctuary Named After Dr. B.R. Ambedkar

The Madhya Pradesh government has announced the establishment of a new wildlife sanctuary named Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Abhyaran in Sagar district. Spanning 258.64 square kilometers, the sanctuary encompasses reserved forest areas in the North Sagar Forest Division, including Banda and Shahgarh tehsils . This initiative, unveiled ahead of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's 134th birth anniversary on April 14, aims to bolster biodiversity conservation and promote eco-tourism in the region. By



dedicating the sanctuary to Dr. Ambedkar, the state pays tribute to his legacy of social justice while emphasizing environmental stewardship. This move reflects Madhya Pradesh's commitment to integrating ecological preservation with inclusive development .

His research and advocacy have significantly influenced public health policies related to bone and mineral disorders. The IOF acknowledged his decades-long commitment to improving patient care and promoting medical education. This global recognition marks a proud moment for Indian medical professionals and highlights Dr. Mithal's lasting impact on global health.

5. James Anderson Receives Knighthood for His Services to Cricket

James Anderson, England's most successful Test bowler, has been awarded a knighthood in former Prime Minister Rishi Sunak's resignation honours list, recognizing his exceptional contributions to cricket over a 21-year international career. Anderson retired from international cricket in July 2024, having taken 704 Test wickets—the most by any English bowler and the third-highest globally—across 188 matches. His achievements include four Ashes victories and a total of 991 wickets across all formats, solidifying his status as one of the game's greats. At 42, Anderson continues to play domestically for Lancashire, despite a recent calf injury sidelining him early in the 2025 season. This honor not only celebrates his on-field accomplishments but also his enduring influence on cricket in England and beyond.

- **Knighthood Honor:** James Anderson, the legendary English fast bowler, has been awarded a knighthood as part of former Prime Minister Rishi Sunak's resignation honors list, recognizing his exceptional contribution to cricket.

6. Ashok Kumar , Director, Department of Justice, appointed as Inspector General


