



### 1. Axar Patel appointed India's Vice-Captain For T20 World Cup 2026

Squad Announcement: The BCCI announced the 15member squad, which includes experienced players like Jasprit Bumrah, Hardik Pandya, and Axar Patel, along with young talents like Rinku Singh and Ishan Kishan.



- Vice-Captaincy: Axar Patel was chosen as the vicecaptain, citing his all-round abilities and experience in pressure situations.
- Shubman Gill Dropped: Gill's omission is attributed to his underwhelming performances, scoring 291 runs from 15 matches at an average of 24.25 and strike rate of 137.26, without a single fifty.
- Ishan Kishan's Return: Kishan has been included in the squad, having earned his place with impressive performances in domestic cricket, including winning the Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy with Jharkhand.
- Tournament Schedule: India will begin their campaign against the USA on February 7, followed by matches against Namibia, Pakistan, and the Netherlands.

#### 2. Parliament Passes Insurance Laws Amendment Bill 2025

100% FDI in Insurance: The bill raises the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) limit in insurance companies from 74% to 100%, allowing foreign promoters to own insurers fully, subject to fit-and-proper and control conditions.



• **Strengthened IRDAI Powers**: The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) will have enhanced powers,

including the authority to disgorge wrongful gains, introduce clearer and more transparent penalty norms, and enable one-time registration for intermediaries.

- Easier Entry for Foreign Reinsurers: The Net Owned Funds requirement for foreign reinsurers will be reduced from ₹5,000 crore to ₹1,000 crore, making it easier for global reinsurers to enter India and expand domestic risk capacity.
- **Greater Autonomy for LIC**: The bill grants operational flexibility to the Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC), enabling faster expansion and more efficient management of overseas operations.
- **Policyholder Protection**: A dedicated Policyholders' Education and Protection Fund will be established to raise awareness about insurance products, and policyholder data will be protected in alignment with the Digital Personal Data Protection (DPDP) Act, 2023.

• **Ishan Kishan's Heroics**: Captain Ishan Kishan led from the front, scoring a blistering 101 off 49 balls, including 10 sixes, to help Jharkhand post a massive 262/3.
