1. CONSECUTIVE (adj): लगातार

Pronunciation: Kuhn.zeh.kyuh.tiv

Meaning: following continuously

Synonym: Successive, sequential, running

Antonym: Interrupted, nonsequential, separate

Sentence: He worked for five consecutive days to finish the project on time.

2. INTEGRITY (noun) : अखंडता

Pronunciation: in.tuh.gruh.tee

Meaning: the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles

Synonym: Honesty, uprightness, probity

Antonym: Dishonesty, corruption, division

Sentence: The integrity of the leader was respected by all her followers.

3. TAMPERING (noun) : छेड़छाड़

Pronunciation: tam.puh.ruhng

Meaning: the action of making unauthorized alterations

Synonym: Interference, meddling, tinker

Antonym: Restoration, repair, shunning

Sentence: Tampering with the device voids the warranty.

4. ELABORATELY (adv): बड़े प्रयास या विस्तार से

Pronunciation: uh.la.buh.ruht.lee

Meaning: in a detailed and carefully arranged manner

Synonym: Intricately, meticulously, in detail

Antonym: Simply, plainly, unfancy

Sentence: The banquet hall was elaborately decorated for the royal reception.

5. DYNAMICS (noun) : गतिकी

Pronunciation: dai.na.muhks

Meaning: the forces or properties that stimulate growth, development, or change within a system or process

Synonym: brawny, refreshed, stout

Antonym: tired, powerless, soft

Sentence: The dynamics of the group changed when the new manager arrived.

6.MANIPULATION (noun) : हेरफेर

Pronunciation: ma.ni.pyoo.lay.shn

Meaning: the action of manipulating someone in a clever or unscrupulous way (हेरफेर)

Synonym: Exploitation, manoeuvring, devise

Antonym: Honesty, straightforwardness, bungle

Sentence: The manipulation of public opinion is a common strategy in politics.

7.EXEGESIS (noun) : टिप्पणी

Pronunciation: ek.suh.jee.suhs

Meaning: critical explanation or interpretation of a text, especially of scripture

Synonym: Analysis, interpretation, explication

Antonym: Misinterpretation, distortion, text

Sentence: His exegesis of ancient texts provided new insights into their meanings.

8. INCHOATE(adj) : अपूर्ण

Pronunciation: inchoate

Meaning: just begun and not fully formed or developed

Synonym: Nascent, embryonic, original

Antonym: Mature, developed, shaped

Sentence: The inchoate ideas eventually formed the basis of his theory.

9.JEJUNE (adj) : नीरस

Pronunciation: juh.joon

Meaning: naive, simplistic, and superficial

Synonym: boring, old, heavy

Antonym: Interesting, surprising, engaging

Sentence: The lecture was so jejune that several students fell asleep.

10.QUIXOTIC (adj) : विलक्षण

Pronunciation: kvuhk.saw.tuhk

Meaning: exceedingly idealistic; unrealistic and impractical (विलक्षण)

Synonym: Visionary, impractical, romantic

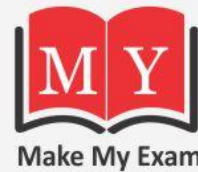
Antonym: Pragmatic, realistic, practical

Sentence: His quixotic quest for the city of gold left him penniless and wandering in the desert.

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
