

1. Kerala becomes first state to have own internet service

- The Kerala Fibre Optic Network (K-FON) has received the Internet Service Provider (ISP) license from the Department of Telecommunications.
- With this, Kerala has become the first and only state in the country to have its own internet service.
- The KFON is envisaged to provide free internet to BPL families and 30,000 government offices.
- The previous Left government had declared internet connection as a basic right and launched the Rs 1,548-crore KFON project in 2019.


4. NITI Aayog, WFP to launch Initiative on mainstreaming millets
