





1. NASA has launched the initiative to construct the Moon's first railway system Foot Notes:

- NASA is creating a lunar railway system named Flexible Levitation on a Track (FLOAT) for transporting payloads on the moon.
- FLOAT aims to support the daily operations of a sustainable lunar base in 2030s.

2. Government lifted the Floor Price on Basmati Rice

The Indian government has abolished the \$950 per tonne minimum export price (MEP) on basmati rice in response to declining paddy prices. The Commerce Ministry has directed the Agricultural and Processed Foods Export Development Authority (Apeda) to process basmati exports without a floor price. **Foot notes:**



• New Delhi exports 4 million to 5 million metric tons of basmati to countries such as Iran, Iraq, Yemen, Saudi Arabia, the UAE and the US.

- A floor price of \$1,200 per metric tonne was set in August to address rising domestic rice prices amid a tight domestic supply and export ban on non-basmati white rice.
- In 2023-24, the country's basmati rice exports totalled \$5.9 billion. In the 2022-23 FY, exports were valued at \$4.8 billion and amounted to 45.6 lakh.

3. Asian Cricket Council Launches Women's U-19 T20 Asia Cup

Asian Cricket Council President Jay Shah announced the launch of Women's U-19 T20 Asia Cup, which will be held biennially and serve as a preparatory event for the Under-19 T20 World Cup. The decision was made during the ACC Executive Board meeting chaired by Shah, who is set to become ICC chairman on December 1.

- In a significant stride towards fostering the growth of women's cricket, the Asian Cricket Council (ACC) has announced the launch of the Women's Under-19 T20 Asia Cup.
- This groundbreaking decision was made during the ACC Executive Board Meeting in Kuala Lumpur.
- This tournament is designed to give emerging female cricketers from Asia the chance to compete on an international stage, providing them with essential experience and preparation.
- It aims to improve the performance of Asian teams on the global stage.

4. Microsoft AI plans to invest 4 billion Euros in France

Microsoft will invest 4 billion Euros (\$4.32 billion) in developing AI, data center, and cloud infrastructure in France. Also, Amazon plans to invest 1.2 billion euros (\$1.3 billion) to enhance its AI capabilities and expand its logistics network for faster deliveries. **Foot Notes:**

- The investment includes bringing up to 25,000 advanced GPUs by 2025.
- The company will expand data centers in Paris and Marseille.
- A new data center campus will be developed in Mulhouse, Grand East Region.

5. India won nine gold medals on the second day of the South Asian Junior Athletics Championship in Chennai

On Day 2 of the South Asian Junior Athletics Championship, the Indian team had a remarkable performance, winning 19 medals, including nine gold. This brought India's total gold medal count to 12, following the three gold medals won on the opening day of the championship.

Foot notes:

- Anisha won India's first gold of the day in women's discus throw with a 49.91m effort, breaking the previous record of 48.60m set by A Bajwa in 2018.
- Amanat Kamboj secured silver with a throw of 48.38m, while Sri Lanka's JH Gauranganie took bronze with 37.95m.
- Neeru Pahtak claimed the ninth gold for India in the women's 400m with a time of 54.50 seconds. Sandra Mol Sabu won silver with 54.82 seconds, and Sri Lanka's K Takshima Nuhansa earned bronze with 55.27 seconds.
- In the men's 110m hurdles, Sri Lanka's WP Sandun Koshala won gold with 14.06 seconds, ahead of India's Nayan Pradip Sarde, who took silver with 14.14 seconds. Sri Lanka's E Vishwa Tharuka won bronze with 14.27 seconds.
