

1.SEQUESTERED (adj.): एकान्त

Pronunciation: suh·kveh·stuhd
Meaning: (of a place) isolated and hidden away.
Synonyms: secluded, cloistered, hidden away
Antonyms: desegregate, integrate, assimilate
Sentence: I found a sequestered spot at the bottom of the garden and lay down with my book.

2.PRESIDIUM (noun) : सभापतिमंडल

Pronunciation: presidiumMeaning: a standing executive committee in a country.Synonyms: administration, council, authorityAntonyms: doormat, employee, flunkieSentence: The presidium has decided to hold this evening's meeting elsewhere.

3.YOKED (verb) : जोड़ना

Pronunciation: yoketMeaning: to put or bring together so as to form a new and longer wholeSynonyms: catenated, chained, compoundedAntonyms: disconnected, disjoined, disunitedSentence: He yoked several ideas together to come up with a new theory

4.RESIDUUM (noun) : बाक़ी

Pronunciation: ruh·zi·joo·uhm
Meaning: a substance or thing that remains or is left behind
Synonyms: leftovers, remainder, remains
Antonyms: body, bulk
Sentence: Even highly decaffeinated coffee contains a tiny residuum of caffeine.

5.FILLIP (noun) : प्रोत्साहन

Pronunciation: fi·luhp **Meaning:** something which acts as a stimulus or boost to activity. **Synonyms:** boost, encouragement, incitement



Antonyms: restraint, restriction, check **Sentence:** The news gave the stock market a big <u>fillip</u>.

6.SHENANIGANS (noun) : धोखाधड़ी

Pronunciation: shuh·na·nuh·gnz
Meaning: secret or illegal activity or maneuvering.
Synonyms: buffoonery, clownery, foolery
Antonyms: behavior, manners, obedience
Sentence: More political <u>shenanigans</u> were exposed in the newspapers today.

7.CONTENTIOUS (adj.) : विवादारूपद

Pronunciation: kuhn·ten·shuhs **Meaning:** causing or likely to cause an argument; controversial. **Synonyms:** controversial, disputable, debatable **Antonyms:** noncontroversial, incontestable, indisputable **Sentence:** Both views are highly <u>contentious</u>.

8.LIAISON (noun) : मेल जोल

Pronunciation: lee·ay·zawn
Meaning: communication or cooperation facilitates a close working relationship between people or organizations.
Synonyms: cooperation, contact, association
Antonyms: disaffiliation, dissociation, incompatibility
Sentence: We maintained a close liaison with the trade union.

9.CORRALLED (verb) : इकट्ठा करना

Pronunciation: kuh raald
Meaning: gather together and confine (a group of people or things).
Synonyms: accumulated, amassed, assembled
Antonyms: dispelled, dispersed, dissipated
Sentence: They corralled the cattle before loading them onto the truck.

10.COUNTENANCING (verb) : स्वीकार करना

Pronunciation: kawn·tuhn·uhnst
Meaning: admit as acceptable or possible.
Synonyms: tolerate, permit, allow
Antonyms: disapproving (of), discountenancing, disfavoring
Sentence: I don't <u>countenance</u> such behavior in children of any age
