1. ANNIHILATE (VERB): मिटा देना

Pronunciation: uh·nai·uh·layt

Meaning: destroy.

Synonyms: wipe out, obliterate.

Antonyms: create

Sentence: A simple bomb could also annihilate a lot of things.

2. CONFER (VERB): प्रदान करना

Pronunciation: kuhn·fuh

Meaning: bestow on.

Synonyms: present with/to, grant to

Antonyms: withhold

Sentence: The Minister may have exceeded the powers conferred on him by Parliament.

3. CRYPTIC (ADJECTIVE): रहस्यपूर्ण

Pronunciation: kript·uhk

Meaning: enigmatic.

Synonyms: mysterious, confusing.

Antonyms: Straightforward

Sentence: He found his boss's utterances too cryptic.

4. DEEM (VERB): मानना

Pronunciation: deem

Meaning: consider.

Synonyms: judge, adjudge

Antonyms: misjudge

Sentence: The event was deemed a great success.

5. UNBRIDLED (ADJECTIVE): निरंकुश

Pronunciation: uhn·brai·dld

Meaning: unrestrained.

Synonyms: unconstrained, uncontrolled

Antonyms: restrained

Sentence: He had a moment of unbridled ambition.

6. HUMILIATE (VERB): अपमानित करना

Pronunciation: hyoo·mi·lee·ayt

Meaning: embarrass.

Synonyms: mortify, humble

Antonyms: aggrandize

Sentence: You'll humiliate me in front of the whole school!

7. INVIGORATE (VERB): पुनः जीवित करना

Pronunciation: uhn·vi·guh·rayt

Meaning: revitalize.

Synonyms: energize, refresh

Antonyms: tire

Sentence: The shower had invigorated her.

8. INTEGRATION (NOUN): एकीकरण

Pronunciation: in·tuh·gray·shn

Meaning: combining of two or more things.

Synonyms: Amalgamation, Blending

Antonyms: Segregation, Separation

Sentence: The aim is to promote closer economic integration.

9. DIVERSE (ADJECTIVE): विभिन्न

Pronunciation: dai·vuhs

Meaning: very different from each other.

Synonyms: Sundry, Various

Antonyms: Similar, Parallel

Sentence: Our society today is quite culturally diverse, with immigrants from all over the world.

10. ADVISORY (ADJECTIVE): सलाहकार

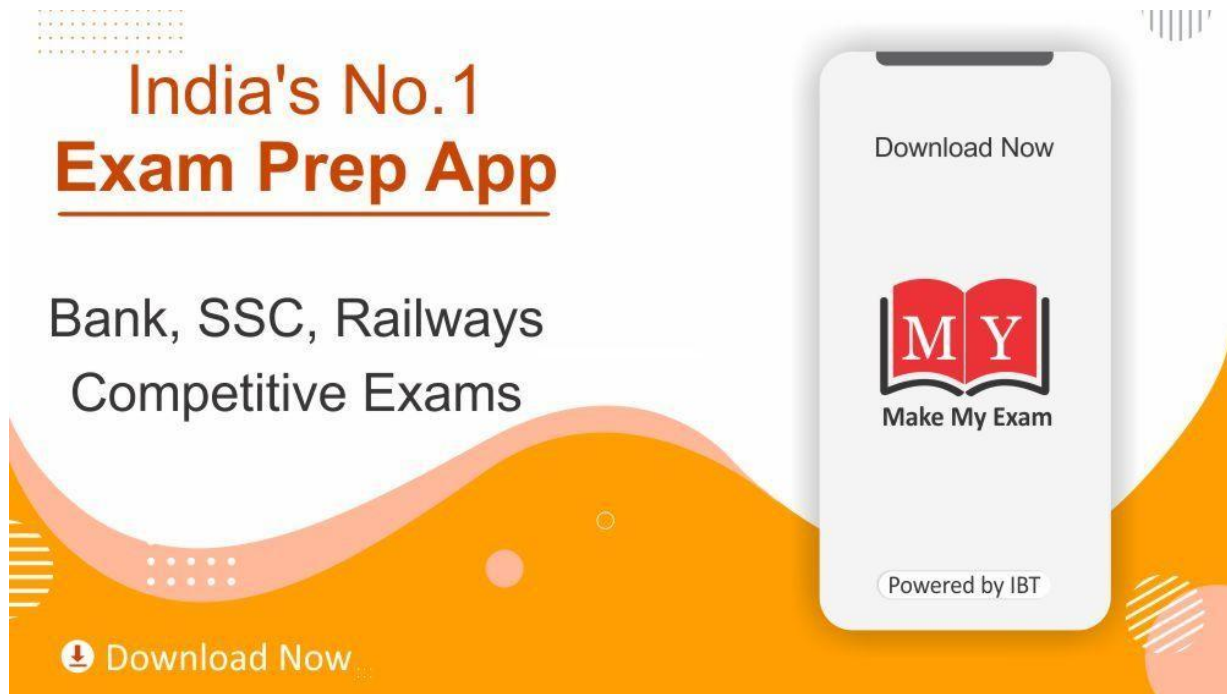
Pronunciation: uh·dvai·zuh·ree

Meaning: relating to giving advice.

Synonyms: Avuncular, Consultative

Antonyms: Uninstructive

Sentence: He attended a meeting of the advisory committee.



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
