

## 1. Manika and Sreeja Shine in ITTF World Cup 2025

Manika Batra and Sreeja Akula delivered outstanding performances in the ITTF World Cup 2025. Representing India, both players showcased remarkable skill and determination on the international stage. Manika impressed the audience with her aggressive play and strategic shots. Sreeja also stood out with her quick reflexes and consistent rallies. - **Group Stage Challenges**: Both Indian paddlers faced tough opponents in the group stage. Manika was grouped with Bruna Takahashi of Brazil (World No. 23) and Maylis Giret, while Sreeja faced Bernadette Szocs of Romania (World No. 13).

# 2. Kerala State Electricity Board signed an agreement with IIT Bombay Institute for V2G



His illustrious career earned him numerous accolades, including the Padma Shri, Padma Bhushan, and Padma Vibhushan.
