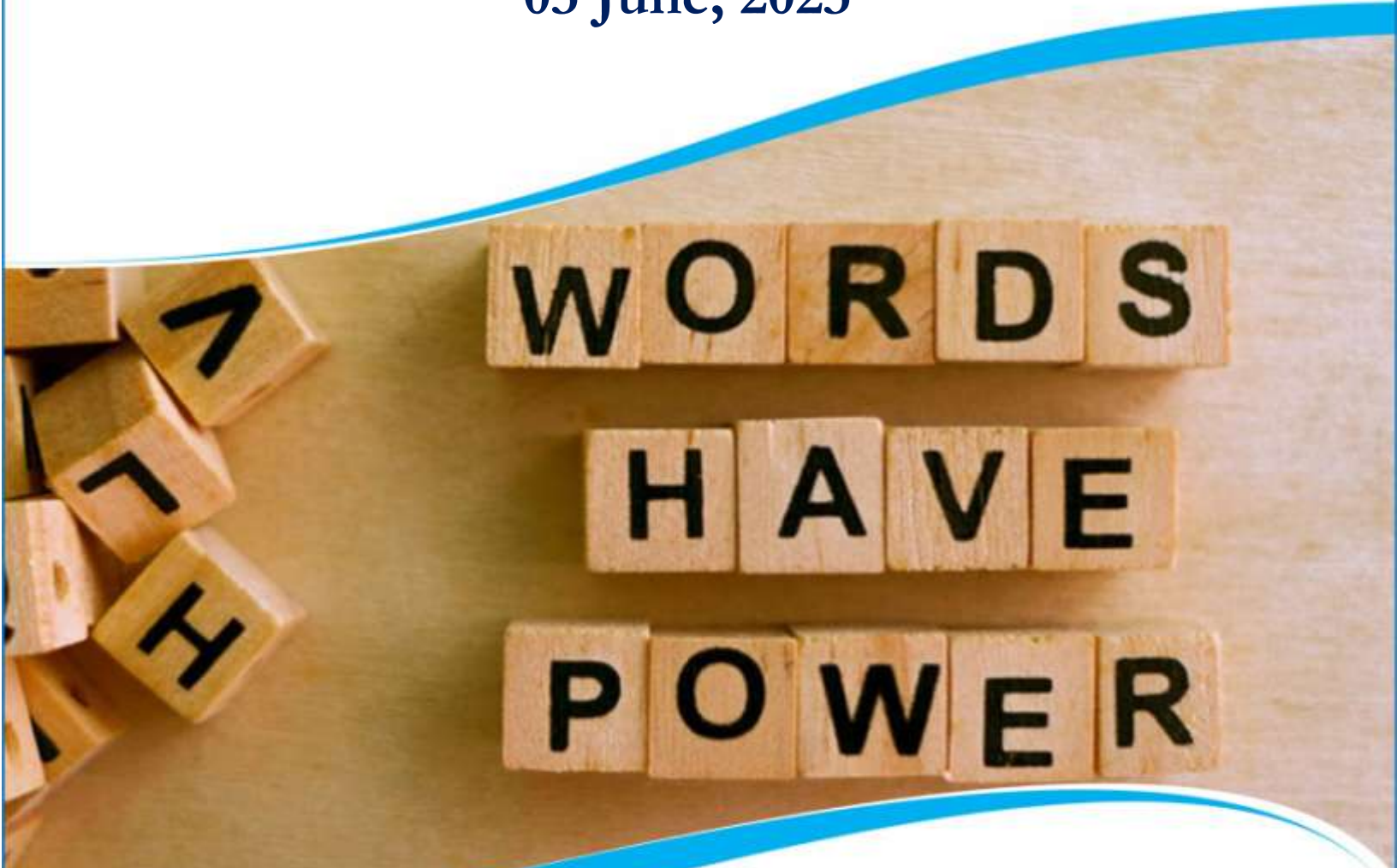

### **1. INADVERTENT (adj.) : बेपरवाह**

**Pronunciation:** in·uhd·vuh·tnt

**Meaning:** not resulting from or achieved through deliberate planning.

**Synonyms:** unintentional, intended

**Antonyms:** careful, cautious

**Sentence:** An inadvertent administrative error occurred that resulted in an overpayment.

### **2. TICKLISH (adj.) : मुश्किल**

**Pronunciation:** ti·kuhl·uhsh

**Meaning:** (of a situation or problem) difficult to deal with; requiring careful handling.

**Synonyms:** problematic, tricky, delicate

**Antonyms:** easy, simple, uncomplicated

**Sentence:** Handling awkward neighbors can be a ticklish business.

### **3. ARGOT (noun) : कठबोली**

**Pronunciation:** aa·goh

**Meaning:** the jargon or slang of a particular group or class.

**Synonyms:** jargon, slang, idiom

**Antonyms:** formal, standard

**Sentence:** Pupils' argot is of particular interest.

### **4. EPIDEMIOLOGICAL (adj.) : महामारी विज्ञान**

**Pronunciation:** eh·puh·dee·mee·uh·law·juhk·uhl

**Meaning:** relating to the branch of medicine that deals with the incidence, distribution, and control of diseases

**Synonyms:** medical, specialty, medicine

**Antonyms:** over-the-counter drug, prescription medicine, prescription drug

**Sentence:** This paper reviews the epidemiological evidence about MMR and autistic enterocolitis.

### **5. DELIMITATION (noun) : हदबंदी**

**Pronunciation:** duh·li·muht·ay·shn

**Meaning:** the action of fixing the boundary or limits of something.

**Synonyms:** custody, detention, incarceration

**Antonyms:** freedom, liberation, liberty

**Sentence:** The delimitation of genera in Oleaceae has always been especially problematic.

### **6. SOPPING (adj.) : तर**

**Pronunciation:** sawp·uhng

**Meaning:** saturated with liquid; wet through.

**Synonyms:** watery, wet, moist

**Antonyms:** arid, dry, unwatered

**Sentence:** Get those sopping clothes off,

### **7. VERNACULAR (noun) : मातृभाषा**

**Pronunciation:** vuh·na·kyoo·luh

**Meaning:** the language or dialect spoken by ordinary people in a particular country or region.

**Synonyms:** everyday language, spoken language

**Antonym:** latin

**Sentence:** Galileo wrote in the vernacular to reach a larger audience.

### **8. BABEL (noun) : कोलाहल**

**Pronunciation:** ba·bl

**Meaning:** a confused noise made by a number of voices.

**Synonyms:** clamor, tumult, uproar

**Antonyms:** quiet, silence, calm

**Sentence:** She hushed the babel of her thoughts and tried to sleep.

### **9. MIEN (noun) : चेहरे का भाव**

**Pronunciation:** meen

**Meaning:** a person's look or manner, especially one of a particular kind indicating their character or mood.

**Synonyms:** appearance, look, expression

**Antonyms:** informality, formality, courtesy.

**Sentence:** He has a cautious, academic mien.

### **10. CONTRAVENE (verb) : अवहेलना करना**

**Pronunciation:** kawn·truh·veen

**Meaning:** violate the prohibition or order of (a law, treaty, or code of conduct).

**Synonyms:** break, breach, defy

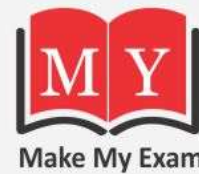
**Antonyms:** obey, follow, comply with
