

#### 1.PUNITIVE (adj.): दंडात्मक

Pronunciation: pyoo•nuh•tuhv

**Meaning:** inflicting or intended as punishment. **Synonyms:** penal, disciplinary, corrective

Antonyms: acquitting, exculpating, nonpunitive

**Sentence:** The UN has imposed <u>punitive</u> sanctions on the invading country.

#### 2.INSURGENT (noun) : विद्रोही

Pronunciation: uhn•sur•jnt

**Meaning:** a rebel or revolutionary. **Synonyms:** mutineer, agitator, rebel **Antonyms:** loyalist, patriot, supporter

**Sentence:** The soldiers were trained to shoot any enemy insurgent on sight.

# 3.DUBIOUS (adj.): संदेहपूर्ण

**Pronunciation:** doo•bee•uhs **Meaning:** hesitating or doubting.

Synonyms: doubtful, uncertain, unsure

Antonyms: undoubted, unproblematic, unquestionable

**Sentence:** I remain <u>dubious</u> about her motives.

# 4.REEK (verb) : बदबू देना

**Pronunciation:** reek

Meaning: smell strongly and unpleasantly

**Synonyms:** stink, smell, disgusting **Antonyms:** aroma, fragrance, perfume

**Sentence:** The kitchen began to <u>reek</u> because he neglected to take out the garbage.

# 5.AWNING (noun): शामियाना

Pronunciation: aa•nuhng

Meaning: a sheet of canvas or other material stretched on a frame and used to keep the sun

or rain off a storefront, window, doorway, or deck.

**Synonyms:** canopy, shade, sunshade **Antonyms:** open, reveal, expose

Sentence: They dashed under an <u>awning</u> to escape the sudden downpour.

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6.PLUNGE (verb) : ग़ोता लगाना

**Pronunciation:** pluhnj

**Meaning:** jump or dive quickly and energetically.

Synonyms: jump, dive, hurl oneself

Antonyms: arise, ascend, lift

**Sentence:** A young boy <u>plunged</u> into the lake from the cliffs.

7.CONFER (verb) : प्रदान करना

**Pronunciation:** kuhn•fur

**Meaning:** grant or bestow (a title, degree, benefit, or right).

**Synonyms**: grant to, award to, honor with **Antonyms**: call off, take back, withdraw

**Sentence:** Nelson Mandela and his wife Graca Machel recently had honorary degrees

conferred on them by Ryerson University in Toronto.

8.PUMMEL (verb) : कूटना

Pronunciation: puh•muhl

**Meaning:** strike repeatedly with the fists.

Synonyms: batter, pound, drub

**Antonyms:** lose, fail

**Sentence:** During the championship, the fighter began to <u>pummel</u> his opponent after

distracting him.

9.SHEEN (noun) : चमक

**Pronunciation:** sheen

**Meaning:** a soft luster on a surface. **Synonyms:** shine, luster, gleam

Antonyms: dirtiness, drabness, dullness

**Sentence:** The conditioner gives the hair a beautiful soft sheen.

10.SLUMBER (verb) : नींद

Pronunciation: sluhm•br


Meaning: fall into a deep peaceful sleep

Synonyms: doze, nap, snooze

**Antonyms:** wakefulness, awakening, consciousness **Sentence:** She fell into a deep and peaceful <u>slumber</u>.

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
