1. Odisha wins women's final in Hockey India Masters Cup

- **Odisha's Victory**: Odisha defeated Punjab 1-0 in the women's final to lift the trophy.
- Match-Winning Goal: Ranjita Beck scored the decisive goal in the 34th minute, showcasing her exceptional skills.
- **Tamil Nadu's Men's Title**: In the men's category, Tamil Nadu dominated Maharashtra with a 5-0 win.
- **Bronze Medal Winners**: Haryana won the bronze medal in the women's category, beating Tamil Nadu 4-3, while Chandigarh took the bronze in the men's category, defeating Odisha 2-1.

2. Australia set to make history with first-ever homegron rocket launch

- Launch Details: Gilmour Space Technologies is targeting July 1-3 for the launch of Eris, the first Australian-made orbital rocket, from the Bowen Orbital Spaceport in Queensland.
- **Rocket Specifications**: The 25-meter tall, three-stage Eris rocket is designed to deliver up to 215 kilograms







to sun-synchronous orbit, with the potential to carry small satellites into low-Earth orbit.

- **Payload**: The rocket will carry a small camera and a jar of Vegemite, Australia's iconic yeast spread, as a symbol of national pride, rather than a commercial payload.
- **Challenges Overcome**: After several delays due to technical issues, including a previous aborted launch and high-altitude winds, the team has completed a full test of the vehicle to ensure safety.

3. Tata Group Becomes First Indian Brand to Cross \$30 Billion in Brand Value

- **Brand Value Milestone:** Tata Group's brand value surged 10% to \$31.6 billion, making it the first Indian brand to surpass the \$30 billion mark, as per Brand Finance's 2025 rankings.
- **Ranking and Position**: Tata Group retained its position as India's most valuable brand for the 15th consecutive year, ranking 60th in the global top 100 brands with a AAA- brand strength rating.



 - Historic Win: Praggnanandhaa won the UzChess • in Tashkent, Cup Masters 2025 Uzbekistan. becoming the top-ranked Indian chess player and surpassing World Chess Champion D Gukesh in live classical ratings.
 - New Ranking: With a live rating of 2778.3, Praggnanandhaa jumped to World No. 4, his highest-ever ranking, and is now ahead of fellow Indian stars D Gukesh (2776.6) and Arjun Erigaisi (2775.7).
 - **Tournament Highlights:** Praggnanandhaa started the final day a point behind local favorite Nodirbek Abdusattorov and half a point behind Javokhir Sindarov. He won the title after a thrilling three-way tie, defeating Sindarov and drawing with Abdusattorov in the blitz playoffs.
 - Third Major Title: This victory marks Praggnanandhaa's third major title of the year, following wins at the Tata Steel Chess Tournament and the Grand Chess Tour Superbet Classic in Romania.










9. National Statistics Day celebrated on 29 June 2025

• Date and Significance: National Statistics Day is celebrated on June 29, marking the birth anniversary of Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis, the father of Indian statistics. This day recognizes the value of statistics in shaping national policy and raising awareness about the importance of data in governance, economy, and society.



• Theme: The theme for National Statistics Day 2025 is

"75 Years of National Sample Survey," highlighting the role of the NSS in providing reliable data for evidence-based decision-making and governance in India.

- **P.C. Mahalanobis' Contributions**: Mahalanobis made significant contributions to statistics, including developing the Mahalanobis Distance, founding the Indian Statistical Institute (ISI), and playing a key role in formulating India's second five-year plan. He was awarded the Padma Vibhushan for his remarkable contributions to science and statistics.
- **Importance in Modern India:** Statistics play a crucial role in India's governance, informing policy decisions in areas like economic planning, health, education, and social welfare.

10. NRL signs MoU with IWT, will supply 80–100 Kiloliter of High Speed Diesel

• MoU Details: NRL signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with IWT on June 26, 2025, to supply 80-100 kiloliters of High-Speed Diesel (HSD) per month to two crucial ferry supply locations: Nemati Ghat and Guwahati Ghat.



- **Purpose**: The agreement aims to ensure **provide** uninterrupted ferry operations, supporting regional connectivity and public transport in Assam, particularly for the people of Majuli, the world's largest river island.
- **Signatories**: The MoU was formally signed by R.M.W. Khongwir, Chief General Manager (Marketing), NRL, and Sushmita Kakati, Director, Inland Water Transport, Government of Assam.
