

#### 1.FILLIP (Noun): (प्रोत्साहन)

Pronunciation: fi-luhpMeaning: something which acts as a stimulus or boost to an activity.Synonyms: stimulus, stimulation, stimulantAntonyms: restraint, restriction, checkSentence: It will save fuel and be a great <u>fillip</u> to the coal industry.

# 2. DRACONION (Adj.): (बेरहम)

Pronunciation: druh.koh.nee.uhn
Meaning: excessively harsh and severe
Synonyms: harsh, severe, strict, extreme
Antonyms: lenient, clement, light
Sentence: It's about time we sorted a sensible compromise and not a <u>draconian</u> law.

## 3.COGNIZANCE (Noun): (ध्यान में रखते)

Pronunciation: cog·ni·zance
Meaning: knowledge, awareness, or notice
Synonyms: awareness, notice, knowledge, consciousness
Antonyms: unawareness, ignorance, nescience
Sentence: He was deputed to bring the affair to the <u>cognizance</u> of the board.

## 4.TIDINGS (noun) : ख़बर

**Pronunciation:** tai·duhngz **Meaning:** news; information. **Synonyms:** news, information, reports **Antonyms:** ignorance, quiet, silence **Sentence:** Have you heard the glad <u>tidings</u>?

#### 5.GROPE (verb) : अंधे की तरह खोजना

Pronunciation: gropeMeaning: feel about or search blindly or uncertainly with the hands.Synonyms: fumble, scrabble, searchAntonyms: aware, seeing, sightedSentence: She got up and groped for her spectacles.



# 6.CONUNDRUM (noun) : पहेली

**Pronunciation:** kuh·nuhn·druhm **Meaning:** a confusing and difficult problem or question. **Synonyms:** problem, difficult question, vexed question **Antonyms:** clarification, solution **Sentence:** This is not merely a curious <u>conundrum</u>.

#### 7.COUNTENANCE(verb) : प्रशंसनीय

Pronunciation: kawn·tuhn·uhnstMeaning: admit as acceptable or possible.Synonyms: permit, allow, approve ofAntonyms: disapproved (of), discountenanced, disfavoredSentence: He was reluctant to <u>countenance</u> the use of force.

#### 8.DEPRAVE (verb) : भ्रष्ट करना

**Pronunciation:** duh prayv **Meaning:** make (someone) immoral or wicked. **Synonyms:** corrupt, lead astray, pervert **Antonyms:** dignify, honor, purify **Sentence:** This book would <u>deprave</u> young children.

#### 9.PRELUDE (noun) : प्रस्तावना

Pronunciation: preh·lyood
Meaning: an action or event serving as an introduction to something more important.
Synonyms: preliminary, overture, opening
Antonyms: aftermath, closing, conclusion
Sentence: Education cannot simply be a prelude to a career.

#### 10.LARGESSE (noun): उदारता

**Pronunciation:** laa·jes **Meaning:** generosity in bestowing money or gifts upon others. **Synonyms:** generosity, liberality, munificence **Antonyms:** cheapness, parsimony, penuriousness **Sentence:** She is not noted for her <u>largesse</u>.
