



1. India Finishes Second Overall in First ISSF World Cup 2025

India finished second overall in the first ISSF World Cup 2025 (Para), showcasing a strong performance on the global stage. Indian para shooters delivered exceptional results, securing multiple medals across various categories. Their consistent efforts and remarkable skills contributed significantly to the country's overall standing. This achievement highlights India's growing dominance and dedication in para shooting sports at the international level.

2. Mohun Bagan Wins ISL 2024-25

Mohun Bagan Super Giant clinched the 2024–25 Indian Super League (ISL) title with a dramatic 2–1 victory over Bengaluru FC in the final, held on April 12, 2025, at the



Vivekananda Yuba Bharati Krirangan in Kolkata. This triumph marked their second ISL Cup win and completed a historic league-cup double, as they had already secured the ISL Shield earlier in the season . This victory also established Mohun Bagan as the first team to successfully defend the ISL Shield, finishing the regular season with a record 56 points and an unbeaten home record .

The committee's composition includes notable figures such as former Afghanistan player Hamid Hassan, West Indies legend Desmond Haynes, South Africa's Test and ODI captain Temba Bavuma, and former England batter Jonathan Trott . The ICC's decision to retain Ganguly



and Laxman underscores their confidence in the duo's ability to guide the sport's development and uphold its integrity.

10. Mario Vargas Llosa A Noble Award Winner passed away

A towering figure in Latin American literature, Vargas Llosa was renowned for works such as Aunt Julia and the Scriptwriter, The War of the End of the World, and The Feast of the Goat. He was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature in 2010 for his exploration of power structures and individual resistance. Beyond literature, he ventured into politics, running for the Peruvian presidency in



1990, though unsuccessfully . In accordance with his wishes, his remains will be cremated without a public ceremony . The Peruvian government has declared a national day of mourning to honor his legacy .
