

1. REVANCHISM (NOUN): बदला लेने की राजनीतिक नीति

Pronunciation: ri.van.chiz.uhm

Meaning: a nice thing that someone says or does to persuade another to do something.

Synonyms: cajolery, charming, charm

Antonyms: disparagement, depreciation, belittlement

Sentence: She resisted his blandishments.

2.OFFING (NOUN): समुद्र का किनारा

Pronunciation: aw-fing

Meaning: time that is to come.

Synonyms: by.and.by, future, hereafter

Antonyms: past, posterity

Sentence: Major changes are in the offin for the company.

3.JADED (ADJECTIVE): क्लांत

Pronunciation: jayd·uhd

Meaning: tired, bored, or lacking enthusiasm, typically after having had too much of

something.

Synonyms: exhausted, fatigued, knackered **Antonyms:** active, energetic, invigorated

Sentence: You look very jaded; you need a holiday.

4.AVOUCHMENT (NOUN): गारंटी, जमानत

Pronunciation: uh.vowch.muhnt

Meaning: a solemn and often public declaration of the truth or existence of something.

Synonyms: declaration, assertion, claim

Antonyms: dispute, question

Sentence: Your avouchment of his good intentions means he won't be disciplined.

5. PANG (NOUN): गतिहीन, निश्चल

Pronunciation: pang

Meaning: a sudden sharp pain or painful emotion.

Synonyms: pain, sting, discomfort

Antonyms: aid, assist, comfort

Sentence: He experienced a sudden pan of conscience.

6.ENCRUST (VERB): चढ़ाना

Pronunciation: uhn·kruhst

Meaning: cover (something) with a hard surface layer.

Synonyms: coagulate, congeal, cover

Antonyms: clean, flourish

Sentence: She arrived home with her knees encrusted with mud.

7.SOLACE (VERB): सांत्वना

Pronunciation: saw·luhs

Meaning: give comfort or consolation to.

Synonyms: comfort, console, cheer

Antonyms: anguish, distress

Sentence: She smiled, as though solaced by the memory.

8.WHITTLE (VERB): छीलना

Pronunciation: vi·tl

Meaning: to cause to diminish gradually by or as if by cutting off bits with a knife.

Synonyms: cut, clip, pare

Antonyms: extend, inflate, swell

Sentence: The president has agreed to whittle down his proposal

9.UNWIELDY (ADJECTIVE): बोझल

Pronunciation: uhn·veeld·ee

Meaning: difficult to use or operate especially because of size, weight, or design.

Synonyms: clumsy, awkward, cumbersome

Antonyms: useful, practical, handy

Sentence: An unwieldy machine that requires two people to operate it.

10. GALORE (ADJECTIVE): प्रचुर मात्रा में

Pronunciation: ga·lore


Meaning: pouring forth in great amounts. **Synonyms:** plentiful, abundant, lavish

Antonyms: poor, sparse, scant

Sentence: There are book shops galore in this town.
