1. VIRILE (adj.) : साहसी

Sentence: He wanted his sons to become strong, virile, and athletic like himself.

2. CARICATURED (verb) : नक़ल बनाना

Pronunciation: ka·ruh·kuh·chuhd
Meaning: make or give a comically or grotesquely exaggerated representation of (someone or something).
Synonyms: parody, satirize, lampoon
Antonyms: flattery, praise, seriousness.
Sentence: He <u>caricatured</u> political leaders of his time.

3. DIMINUTION (noun) : कमी

Pronunciation: di·muh·nyoo·shn
Meaning: a reduction in the size, extent, or importance of something.
Synonyms: reduction, lessening, lowering
Antonyms: boost, raise, gain
Sentence: Regular exercise can result in a general <u>diminution</u> in stress levels.

4. CAPRICE (noun) : अप्रत्याशित परिवर्तन

Pronunciation: kuh·prees
Meaning: a sudden and unaccountable change of mood or behavior.
Synonyms: whim, vagary, fancy
Antonyms: firmness, solidity, steadiness
Sentence: An out-of-character <u>caprice</u> led him to take the day off from work and go to the beach.

5. FLIMFLAM (noun) : बकवास

Pronunciation: flim.flam **Meaning:** nonsensical or insincere talk.



Synonyms: balderdash, baloney, idiocy **Antonyms:** reasonableness, sensibleness **Sentence:** I was sick of his intellectual <u>flimflam</u>.

6. APPENDED (verb) : जुड़ा हुआ

Pronunciation: uh·pend·uhd Meaning: to join (something) to a mass, quantity, or number so as to bring about an overall increase Synonyms: added, adjoined, annexed Antonyms: deducted, knocked off, removed Sentence: Footnotes have been appended to the document.

7. INADMISSIBLE (adj.) : अस्वीकार्य

Pronunciation: in·uhd·mis·uh·bl
Meaning: (especially of evidence in court) not accepted as valid.
Synonyms: not allowable, invalid, not acceptable
Antonyms: admissible, allowable, permissible
Sentence: The judge ruled that the evidence was <u>inadmissible</u>.

8. INVIOLABLE (adj.) : अनुल्लंघनीय

Pronunciation: uhn·vai·uh·luh·bl **Meaning:** not to be violated, criticized, or tampered with **Synonyms:** inalienable, absolute, unbreakable **Antonyms:** alienable, breakable, profane **Sentence:** Everyone has an <u>inviolable</u> right to protection by a fair legal system.

9. DELINEATING (verb) : का वर्णन किया

Pronunciation: duh·li·nee·ayt·uhng
Meaning: describe or portray (something) precisely.
Synonyms: describe, set forth, depicting
Antonyms: confuse, distort
Sentence: The law should <u>delineate</u> and prohibit behavior that is socially abhorrent.

10. FRAILTY (adj.) : निर्बलता

Pronunciation: frayl·tee
Meaning: the condition of being weak and delicate.
Synonyms: infirmity, infirmness, weakness
Antonyms: robustness, strength, vigor
Sentence: Despite increasing physical <u>frailty</u>, he continued to write stories.
